During clinical research of the dog named above on (date) _____ I concluded the following:

Patella "normal": I did not find any indication for the existence of any abnormal movement on one or both sides for the patella medial or lateral.

Flexibel knee cap: The horizontal slide ability of the patella (left and/or right) is quite large (inside and/or outside), however it cannot be dislocated.

There is a patella-luxation **grade 1** (MPL/LPL1)

The patella (left and/or right) is not sufficiently stable. It can be dislocated by turning the tibia and/or by lateral pressure to the outside and/or inside

There is a patella-luxation **grade 2** (MPL/LPL2)

The patella (left and/or right) spontaneously dislocates (inside and/or outside) during standing and/or walking

There is a patella-luxation **grade 3** ((MPL3 / LPL3).

There is a permanent patella-luxation present. The patella can still be put back in its normal position, but will dislocate immediately.

There is a patella-luxation **grade 4** (MPL/LPL4)

There is a permanent patella-luxation present. The patella cannot be put back in its normal position.
